Earrings



Children are **not permitted** to wear the following types of earrings to school:



Hooped, dangly or big earrings are not acceptable due to the Health and Safety risk to the child wearing it and to others – for example, a child could get their earring caught on clothing or equipment resulting in the earring being forcibly pulled out causing an injury.

The only jewellery allowed in school are small stud earrings shown here:



If children come to school with these kinds of earrings parents and/or children will be asked to remove them, it may result in a call home to come and remove your child's earrings.

We encourage parents to support us so that the health and safety of children is not compromised.

Children should **not come to school with any earrings** or jewellery on PE days. They are as follows:

Tuesday – Year 2

Thursday – Year 1

Friday – Reception
