Dear Parent/Carer

The government has recognised the importance for parents of primary school children to have access to term time wraparound childcare in their local area between 8am and 6pm.

Wraparound childcare refers to childcare that wraps around the conventional school day and is often referred to as breakfast clubs or after school clubs. Wraparound care takes place on site at the school or in a linked provision close by. It can be run by the school or through a partner in the private or voluntary sector. This does not include school run activities or clubs that do not always meet the childcare needs of working parents. Wraparound childcare will need to be paid for by parents.

Childcare fees will be set by each provider. However, parents eligible for tax-free childcare or universal credit childcare will be able to use that support to help pay for wraparound care.

Derby City Council invites you to complete a survey to help us shape and support the expansion of Wraparound Childcare for Primary School children in Derby to meet the needs of children, parents, carers and families.

Parents in Derby should expect to see an expansion in the availability of wraparound childcare from April 2025.
