Our topic this half term is Dinosaur Planet.

<p>Reading & Phonics</p> <p>Reading will be based around a dinosaur theme and include the reading and comparing of a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bumpus Jumpus Dinosaurumpus • The Dinosaur who lost her voice • Stomp Dinosaur Stomp • The Dinosaur who pooped Christmas • 100 Dinosaur facts <p>Key reading skills will continue to be taught using our super seven reading buddies, focusing on a key character each week..</p> <p>Please continue to read on a daily basis with your child at home and remember to send your child with their reading book every day.</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>Writing skills will be taught in a fun and exciting way engaging pupils through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Role play • Poetry - looking at rhyming words • Writing stories by becoming authors and illustrators • Diary entries • Instructional writing <p>The handwriting skills which we used last term will still be in use this term. We will also be continuing to write all the phonemes we can hear in a word (phase 3 and 5). We will be learning what a verb is too.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Children will be taught the concept of part-part-whole and develop their knowledge of number bonds to 10.</p> <p>They will begin counting beyond 20, recognising patterns in number.</p> <p>The children will also be introduced to addition and subtraction, using a range of concrete resources and pictorial representations to secure their understanding of these operations. The children will also solve word problems using addition and subtraction.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Our science topic for this half term is focused around animals, including humans. This will link to our topic on dinosaurs.</p> <p>As part of our topic we will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investigate what a carnivore, herbivore and an omnivore is. • Name a variety of different animals E.g. birds, reptiles and mammals. • Explore the structure of these animals. • Explore the diet of these animals. 	<p>Design and Technology</p> <p>Design</p> <p>The problem which the children will have to solve to this term will be based around healthy eating. They will have to design a healthy sandwich.</p> <p>Make</p> <p>Children will learn how to chop and spread independently using the utensils correctly and safely.</p> <p>Evaluate</p> <p>They will then get the chance to then reflect on if their sandwich was healthy or unhealthy. They will also think critically about what they could do better next time.</p>
<p>PE</p> <p>In Year 1, we will participate in both indoor and outdoor PE sessions. Please ensure that your child comes to school in their PE kit on a Thursday.</p> <p>Children will take part in a 3 minute stamina run at the start of each PE session to improve their overall fitness.</p> <p>We will be staying active and learning about dance this half term by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creating dinosaur dance sequences. 	<p>Computing</p> <p>Computing will be taught on a two-week cycle. This term the focus will be on using technology for a specific purpose.</p> <p>The children will be learning more about a laptop; the key features and what they are used for. We will also be learning simple keyboard skills (such as using the letter keys and the track pad) so we are able to log into a simple programme.</p> <p>Children will also be taught the importance of e-safety when we go through our Pear Tree Infants School E-safety rules at the start of every lesson.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>As part of promoting British values, children will learn about different festivals and celebrations and their associating religion. Children will learn and build on their knowledge relating to Christianity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exploring the stories of David and Goliath and Noah's Ark. • The Nativity. <p>Children will engage in a range of exciting activities to explore the ideas and deepen their understanding.</p> <p>The children will also rehearse and perform the Christmas Nativity.</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>This term's learning will explore being healthy. This will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to keep our bodies and minds healthy. • Understanding the important of personal hygiene. 	<p>Geography</p> <p>We will be learning about the United Kingdom.</p> <p>We will focus on locating and naming the four countries and capital cities in the UK.</p> <p>We will use maps to help us with our knowledge and understanding.</p>
